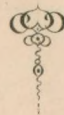

Attended Missouri Dental College and St. Louis College of Medicine, 1870-71.  
Practiced dentistry in Father's office, Lincoln County, Mo., 1871-72.  
Practiced dentistry in Waverly, Ill., 1872-1876.  
Practiced dentistry in Quincy, Ill., 1876-1881, also 1882-1889.

Attended Missouri Dental College and St. Louis Medical College, 1881-82.  
Attended Quincy College of Medicine, 1884-85, graduating 1885.  
Taught Microscopy and Histology, Quincy College of Medicine, 1885-89.
