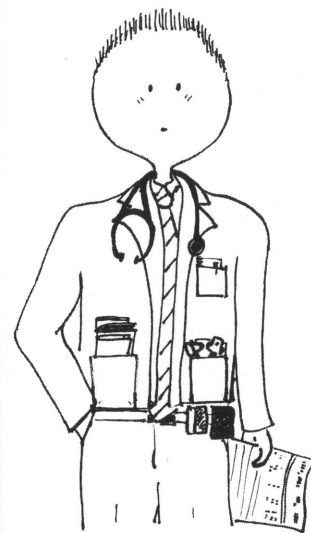
**LIFE** - Change every space to say "Put this on hold for the next six to ten years, forget about a family, friends, or income, and roll again, just for the fun of it."
