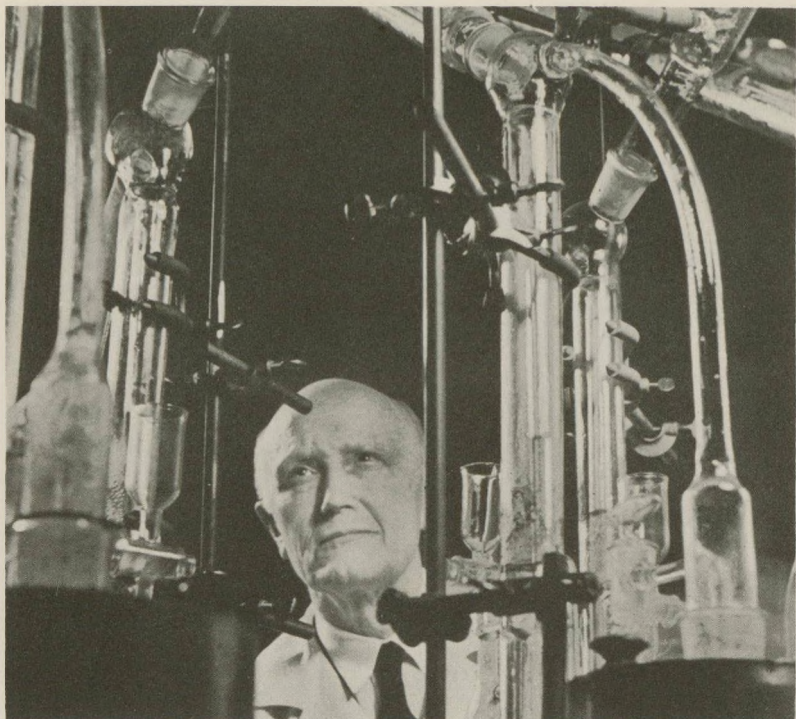




DR. FRED CONRAD KOCH
